

Pride of Australia Medal 2017

Rules of Entry

To be considered for a Pride of Australia Medal, your nominee must satisfy the Rules of Entry, found below.

News Limited is the organiser and promoter of the Pride of Australia Medal Program.

The instructions below comprise The Pride of Australia Medal Program's Rules of Entry. Failure to comply with the Rules of Entry may result in a nomination being disqualified.

All nominations must be received no later than midnight on Sunday 19 November, 2017.

Nominees will be judged on actions and contributions made since 1 January, 2017.

Nominations must be made on an official Pride of Australia Nomination Form online at the relevant masthead via the website as listed below. Photocopies of official entry forms will be accepted.

Rules of Entry

All nominations must be the original work of the author and factually accurate, to the best of the nominator's knowledge.

Nominees must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident.

Nominees are not restricted by age.

Nominations are available for individuals and groups of 2-10 people.

All nominations submitted become the sole property of News Limited and will not be returned.

News Limited is not responsible for illegible, late, lost, damaged or misdirected mail or for postage due.

Only nominees who are chosen as finalists will be contacted and asked for permission to proceed through the judging phase. Those contacted will be required to agree to comply with these rules of entry and agree to participate in all promotional activities.

All award finalists and medallists will be required to sign a statutory declaration, must provide three character referees and submit to a standard Australian Federal Police check.

The final judging of the nominations will be conducted by a panel of judges appointed by News Limited and finalists will be notified by phone.

Judges decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Medals and finalist certificates will be presented to winners at their home or workplace in the state or territory in which they have been nominated.

Nominees, finalists and medallists may be published by News Limited publications and appear on broadcasts by its media partners.

Each nominator assigns to the Promoter all copyright and other intellectual property rights in all material (written and photographic) sent in as part of a nomination in the Pride of Australia Medal program.

Each nominator acknowledges that the Promoter, as owner of the copyright in the material, may reproduce or transmit the material in any media for any purpose throughout the world without permission or payment.

Each nominator waives their moral rights in the material which they submit with their nomination.

Each nominator assures the Promoter that it is the owner of the material which the nominator has submitted as part of the nomination and that if the Promoter uses any of that material as contemplated above it will not breach any person's rights (including copyright or moral rights).

The Promoter collects information about you and your nominee to include you and your nominee in the Pride of Australia Medal program, and where appropriate, to award medals and publish articles about the nominees.

The Promoter may also use the information to assist in improving its goods and services.

The Promoter may share your information with its Australian related companies and partners and the Promoter may contact you in relation to the Pride of Australia Medal Program or similar programs in future years. The Promoter may also share your information with other persons or entities who are assisting in running the Pride of Australia Medal Program.

The Promoter would like to share your information with these overseas related companies, but if you would prefer us not to, please write to the privacy officer in your relevant state or territory. You can also gain access to your personal information by contacting the privacy officer.
